## Contest rules/guidelines:

- Logos must be submitted no later than 4pm on November 4<sup>th</sup> 2011
- Incorporate the words "Niagara Envirothon"
- Must be distinct from Ontario Envirothon logo (shown at the right)
- Can be submitted digitally or on paper

- **The winning school will receive free registration for the 2012 Niagara Envirothon as well as an individual prize for the artist(s).**
- The Niagara Envirothon Steering Committee will review the entries and announce the winning logo on November 25<sup>th</sup> 2011
- The Steering Committee reserves the right to make alterations to the logo if necessary

## Some Things to Consider:

### *Number of colours*

The number of different colours in the logo is important, the fewer the better and the easier to replicate. It should be easy to change the logo to black and white or grayscale if necessary for printing, etc.

### *Keep it simple*

The logo should also take into account that it will need to be scaled up and down for different purposes (posters, t-shirts, banners, etc.). The logo should be scalable to any size without losing the quality of the image or the visual impact.
