NPCA Membership Pass Terms and Conditions:

By purchasing a Membership Pass, the Member understands and agrees to the following:

1. A "Membership Pass" (referred to as the Pass) includes the Pass and any associated Rewards and Privileges; the "Member" is the person named on the Pass; and the "NPCA" is the Niagara Peninsula Conservation Authority.
2. The Pass grants revocable license to the Member named on the Pass for admission on any regularly scheduled day of operation.
3. In addition to the Member, admission may include up to five "guests" (depending on location/event) who arrive at the NPCA property as passengers in the member's vehicle. Commercial or multiple vehicles are not permitted entry under a Pass.
4. Passes must be presented to NPCA staff on entry. Member may be required to show photo ID.
5. All hours and operating schedules are subject to change, without notice or refund.
6. All events are subject to closing/cancellation due to weather conditions or venue capacity without notice or refund.
7. The Pass may not be used in conjunction with any other promotional offer unless specified.
8. The Pass is non-refundable, may not be sold or transferred; and will not be replaced if expired, lost, stolen or destroyed.
9. The Pass may not be used for advertising promotion (including contests/sweepstakes) or other purposes without prior written consent of the Niagara Peninsula Conservation Authority.
10. A Pass may not be used to access any NPCA property for commercial/business purposes without prior written consent.
11. Improper use of the Pass may result in confiscation of the Pass without refund; eviction from the premises; a ban from NPCA properties; and prosecution under applicable laws.
12. While on NPCA properties, the Member and his/her party agree to abide by all laws, regulations, policies and conditions of use applicable on NPCA property. 13. Photographs or video images taken of NPCA properties may not be used for commercial purpose without the express written consent of the NPCA. The NPCA reserves the right to take photos/video of guests while on NPCA property.
14. In all cases where "prior written consent" is required, that document must be in the possession of the pass holder and be provided to staff on request.
15. NPCA visitors are advised that video surveillance may be in use at NPCA properties.
16. Release: Pass Members and their guests assume all risks and hazards associated with their visit to all NPCA Conservation Areas; and further release the NPCA, its management, employees, partners or agents from liability from any personal injury, property loss or damage, regardless of cause.

- "Guest" admission privileges.*
- Pass valid for One Full Year from date of purchase.
- \$5 "Early Renewal" discount to existing Members (seniors excluded).
- \$10 Senior Membership discount (persons age 65+).
- 10% Member Discount for programs that require registration.*
- An Additional Vehicle Permit for overnight camping at Long Beach C.A./Chippawa Creek C.A. when purchased in conjunction with a campsite permit. Restrictions apply (value = compare at \$12/night).

Discounts on Camping and Rentals as follows:

- 50% off weekday roofed Pavilion rentals at Ball's Falls C.A., Binbrook C.A., Chippawa Creek C.A. or Long Beach C.A. (\$32.50 value)
- 50% off weekday barbecue rentals at Binbrook C.A., Chippawa Creek C.A. or Long Beach C.A. (\$5 value)
- 50% off weekday Open Air Picnic Area rentals at Binbrook C.A. (\$15 value)
